




Dear members of MIJARC.

As you know MIJARC World gets a Solidarity Fund every year, which supports rural youth work worldwide.

Normally this money is collected by rural youth groups and sent to the Solidarity Fund bank account. The fund is annually distributed among the different continents, MIJARC World and the Emergency Fund (aimed at supporting member organisations of MIJARC that really had big difficulties or suffered from catastrophes, to clearly improve their situation).

Since 2013 a percentage of the collected money is dedicated to **local**, **diocesan or national projects** in each continent. Hereby we launch the call 2015, inviting all the interested European members of MIJARC World to send us their applications for this support.

The distribution of the Solidarity Fund in 2015 will follow the following scheme (the amounts in EUR are only an estimation, and can still slightly change):



Applications should be sent using the enclosed Application Form, via e-mail to a.silva@mijarc.net, no later than **30**th **June 2015**.

In case of need for further details or clarifications concerning an application the contact person will be contacted by the Solidarity Committee, who is responsible of collecting all applications and make recommendations to the World Coordination, which in its turn decides which projects are awarded.

If a project is selected the applicant will be contacted by the World Team who will establish a grant contract before releasing the funds. A progress/final report will be requested afterwards.

We are looking forward to receive requests for this support from **national**, **diocesan and local levels**. Therefore, please forward this call as widely as possible within your movements, in order to reach your grassroots.

We take this opportunity to encourage every member to also contributing to this Solidarity Fund through any personal contribution or fundraising activity you could organise. All together, with small contributions, we can make this fund support more and more rural youth projects all over the world.
